

Requirements to be a Kairos Inside Weekend Leader

NOTE: A person can only lead 1 Kairos Weekend ever between all 3 programs. (Variance from KPML required to override)

Clergy may not lead a Kairos Weekend

Nominee must serve at least 3 Weekends before being a Weekend Leader. (Could be Weekend Leader on their 4th Kairos Weekend)

Nominee must give a minimum of two different Talks or Meditations before leading a Kairos Weekend.

Qualifying Talks:

- a. Choices
- b. Friendship with God
- c. The Church
- d. Opening the Door
- e. Discovery Through Study
- f. Christian Action
- g. Obstacles to Accepting God's Grace

Qualifying Meditations:

- a. The Wall Meditation
- b. The Rooster Story

Nominee must serve at least one Weekend seated at a family table for the entire 3½-Day Weekend as a:

- a. Family Leader
- b. Family Assistant

Nominee must hold at least one of these positions before being a Kairos Weekend Leader:

- a. Inside Coordinator
- b. Head Servant
- c. Chapel Coordinator
- d. Agape Coordinator

Nominee must serve as Observing Leader the Weekend immediately prior to being a Kairos Weekend Leader (Variance required for any change to this)

Nominee must attend AKT prior to serving as an Observing Leader

Nominee must attend AKT 12-24 months prior to leading a Kairos Weekend

Nominee must use EZRA software (order EZRA after completing AKT and 6-9 months prior to Leading a Kairos Weekend)
